	The Magnetic Hill is a gravity hill, a type of optical illusion, located at the northern edge of the city of Moncton and has been a top attraction in New Brunswick for over 100 years. See for yourself as vehicles roll uphill without power! Magnetic or magic? Built as a traditional Maritime fishing village setting, the Wharf Village consists of 5 different gift shops, a licensed family style restaurant, Beavertails Pastry shop, an ice cream parlour, and a fudge factory.

	Shediac is renowned for its lobster and has proclaimed itself "Lobster Capital of the World." The town's mascot and logo is a fiberglass lobster 35 feet long, 15 feet wide and 16 feet tall, sculpted by Winston Bronnum in 1989 attracting about 500,000 visitors each year!

	Located at the juncture of the Confederation Bridge linking PEI to New Brunswick, Cape Jourmain is built in an area protected by the Canadian Wildlife Service. Enjoy Spectacular views of the Confederation Bridge, Northumberland Strait coastline and the Historic lighthouse.
